#### Natural Resources - Shark or Elasmobranch Fins - Prohibition Restriction 2 3 on Possession or Distribution

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from possessing, selling, offering for sale, 5 trading, or distributing a shark or other elasmobranch fin; exempting a certain 6 person from the prohibition against possessing a shark fin under certain 7 circumstances; authorizing a certain person to use a ray or skate as bait under 8 certain circumstances; establishing certain civil penalties for violations of this 9 Act; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to adopt regulations to 10 implement this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to a 11 prohibition against restriction on the possession or distribution of a shark or 12 other elasmobranch fin.
