2 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Newborn Screening Program Fund 3 – Establishment

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Newborn Screening Program Fund; requiring the 5 Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to administer the Fund; providing for the 6 uses, purposes, sources of funding, investment of money, and auditing of the Fund; 7 providing that the Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund not subject to certain 8 provisions of law; requiring the Secretary to pay certain fees to the Comptroller; 9 requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain fees to the Fund; requiring interest 10 earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; exempting the Fund from a certain provision of law requiring interest on State money in special funds to accrue to the 11 General Fund of the State; defining a certain term; making this Act an emergency 12 measure; and generally relating to the Newborn Screening Program Fund in the 13 14 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.
