3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain organizations in Carroll County to conduct an 4 event that is a card game, card tournament, or casino night under certain 5 circumstances; requiring an organization to obtain a permit from the Board of 6 License Commissioners before conducting an event; requiring an organization 7 that seeks a permit to meet certain requirements; specifying that an event may 8 be managed and organized by certain organizations; requiring an individual 9 who participates in or helps operate an event to be of a certain age; specifying 10 that a permit holder may receive a certain maximum number of permits in a 11 calendar year; providing a certain time limit on certain events; specifying that a 12 permit is not transferable; requiring that proceeds from an event be used for 13 certain purposes and may not be used for other purposes; specifying that the 14 operation of an event may not occur during a certain time; authorizing a permit 15 holder under this Act to charge only a pre-set entrance fee; requiring 16 participants in a gaming event under this Act to use tokens and not cash for 17 wagering under certain circumstances; prohibiting a permit holder from 18 exchanging tokens under certain circumstances; requiring a permit holder to submit a financial report to the Sheriff's Office under certain circumstances; 19 20 authorizing the governing body of the county to adopt certain regulations; 21 providing a certain penalty; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 22gaming in Carroll County.

NIGHT CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SECTION:

- 1 (1) SHALL BE USED TO BENEFIT A CHARITY OR TO FURTHER THE 2 PURPOSE OF THE PERMIT HOLDER; AND
- 3 (2) MAY NOT BENEFIT FINANCIALLY OR BE USED FOR THE 4 PERSONAL USE OF AN INDIVIDUAL OR A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS.
- 5 (H) A PERMIT MAY NOT AUTHORIZE THE OPERATION OF A CARD GAME, 6 CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO NIGHT AFTER 1 A.M. ON SUNDAY.
- 7 (I) (1) AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY 8 CHARGE ONLY A PRE-SET ENTRANCE FEE FOR A CARD GAME, CARD 9 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO NIGHT.

- 25 (K) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER HOLDING A CARD GAME, CARD 26 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO NIGHT, THE ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT 27 HOLDER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CARROLL COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE A 28 FINANCIAL REPORT THAT LISTS THE RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE 29 CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO NIGHT.
- (L) IN ADDITION TO BEING SUBJECT TO § 13–909 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS FOUND TO HAVE VIOLATED THIS SECTION IS INELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A PERMIT UNDER THIS SECTION FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS.
