## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 – Prince George’s County**  
3 **– YMCA Renaissance Square**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006  
5 to alter the purpose of a certain grant; changing the grantee of a certain grant;  
6 and extending the deadline by which the grantee must present evidence that a  
7 matching fund will be provided.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Chapter 46 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2006  
10 Section 1(3) Item ZA02(BX)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Chapter 46 of the Acts of 2006**

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That:

16 (3) ZA02 LOCAL HOUSE OF DELEGATES INITIATIVES

17 (BX) [YMCA Renaissance Square.] **3505 HAMILTON STREET.**  
18 Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$200,000 or (ii) the  
19 amount of the matching fund provided, to the [Board of  
20 Directors of YMCA Metropolitan Washington, Inc.] **MAYOR**  
21 **AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HYATTSVILLE** for the  
22 [design, and construction, including related site preparation,  
23 of the YMCA Renaissance Square.] **REPAIR AND**  
24 **RENOVATION OF THE BUILDING AT 3505 HAMILTON**

1           **STREET**, located in Hyattsville. **NOTWITHSTANDING**  
 2           **SECTION 1(5) OF THIS ACT, THE MATCHING FUND MAY**  
 3           **CONSIST OF REAL PROPERTY OR FUNDS EXPENDED**  
 4           **PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT AND THE**  
 5           **GRANTEE HAS UNTIL JUNE 1, 2012, TO PRESENT**  
 6           **EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE PROVIDED**  
 7           (Prince George’s County) ..... 200,000

8           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 9           June 1, 2010.
