1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sales and Use Tax – Tax-Free Period for Back-to-School Shopping – Sale of**
3 **Sewing Items**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain sales and use tax exemption to include certain sewing
5 items with a taxable price that is less than a certain amount; defining a certain term;
6 and generally relating to the annual sales and use tax exemption period for
7 back-to-school shopping in the State.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Tax – General**

16 11–228.

17 (a) **(1)** In this section[, “accessory items”] **THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE**
18 **THE MEANINGS INDICATED.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

1 **(2) “ACCESSORY ITEMS”** includes jewelry, watches, watchbands,
2 handbags, handkerchiefs, umbrellas, scarves, ties, headbands, and belt buckles.

3 **(3) (I) “SEWING ITEM” MEANS ANY MATERIAL USED TO MAKE**
4 **CLOTHING.**

5 **(II) “SEWING ITEM” INCLUDES FABRIC, THREAD, ZIPPERS, BIAS**
6 **TAPE, AND ELASTIC.**

7 **(III) “SEWING ITEM” DOES NOT INCLUDE SEWING MACHINES OR**
8 **SEWING TOOLS, SUCH AS PINS, PIN CUSHIONS, SCISSORS, AND NEEDLES.**

9 (b) (1) Beginning in calendar year 2010, the 7-day period from the second
10 Sunday in August through the following Saturday shall be a tax-free period for
11 back-to-school shopping in Maryland during which the exemption under paragraph (2) of
12 this subsection shall apply.

13 (2) During the tax-free period for back-to-school shopping established
14 under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the sales and use tax does not apply to:

15 (i) the sale of any item of clothing or footwear, excluding accessory
16 items, if the taxable price of the item of clothing or footwear is \$100 or less; [or]

17 (ii) the first \$40 of the taxable price of any backpack or bookbag; **OR**

18 **(III) THE SALE OF ANY SEWING ITEM, IF THE TAXABLE PRICE OF**
19 **THE ITEM IS \$100 OR LESS.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
21 1, 2021.
