- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) The president of the county board is entitled to receive [\$10,000] **\$20,000** 16 annually as compensation, the vice president is entitled to receive [\$9,000] **\$19,000**
- 17 annually as compensation, and, except for the student member, the other board members
- are entitled to receive [\$8,000] **\$18,000** each annually as compensation.
- 19 (b) A student member who completes a full term on the county board shall be 20 granted a scholarship of \$8,000 to be applied toward the student's higher education costs.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
