A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Law Enforcement Handgun Disposal – Deceased Officers**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a law enforcement agency to transfer the handgun of a
4 law enforcement officer who is killed or dies in the performance of duty to
5 certain members of the deceased officer’s family or to the deceased officer’s
6 estate; authorizing a law enforcement agency to render the handgun of a
7 deceased officer inoperable before transfer; and generally relating to the
8 disposal of handguns by law enforcement agencies.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Public Safety**

17 3–501.

18 (a) In this section, “manufacturer” has the meaning stated in § 5–131(a)(2) of
19 this article.

20 (b) **[A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A**
21 law enforcement agency seeking to dispose of a handgun owned by the agency shall:

22 (1) destroy the handgun;

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (2) sell, exchange, or transfer the handgun to another law enforcement
2 agency for official use by that agency;

3 (3) sell the handgun to a retired police employee in accordance with §
4 2-415(c) of this article;

5 (4) sell the handgun to the law enforcement officer to whom the
6 handgun was assigned; or

7 (5) sell, exchange, or transfer the handgun to a manufacturer.

8 **(C) (1) IF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS KILLED OR DIES IN THE**
9 **PERFORMANCE OF DUTY, A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY TRANSFER THE**
10 **HANDGUN OF THE DECEASED OFFICER TO:**

11 **(I) A MEMBER OF THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY OF THE**
12 **DECEASED OFFICER; OR**

13 **(II) THE ESTATE OF THE DECEASED OFFICER.**

14 **(2) A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY RENDER THE HANDGUN**
15 **OF THE DECEASED OFFICER INOPERABLE BEFORE TRANSFERRING THE**
16 **HANDGUN.**

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2012.
