- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- Article Education
  7-203.3.
  (A) FOR EACH ASSESSMENT ADMINISTERED IN A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM,
  EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  (1) THE TITLE OF THE ASSESSMENT;
  (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE ASSESSMENT;
