16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Local Government**

1 (a) This section applies to all counties, including Baltimore City.

2 (b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this subtitle, a person shall obtain a  
3 kennel license from the local licensing agency if the person:

4 (1) owns or has custody of [15] ~~8~~ 6 or more unspayed female dogs over the  
5 age of 6 months kept for the purpose of breeding the dogs and selling their offspring; [and]  
6 **OR**

7 (2) sells dogs from six or more litters in a year.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2017.
