5 FOR the purpose of authorizing, for purposes of filing a certain petition for certain 6 immigration status, a certain victim or victim's family member to request a certain 7 certifying official to certify victim helpfulness on a Form I-918, Supplement B 8 certification under certain circumstances; providing that, for the purpose of this Act, a victim shall be considered to be helpful, to have been helpful, or likely to be helpful 9 10 under certain circumstances; requiring the certifying official to sign and complete 11 the certification in a certain manner and within a certain period of time under certain circumstances; providing that certain conditions are not required in order to 12 13 request or obtain the certification; authorizing the certifying official to withdraw the 14 certification only under certain circumstances; authorizing a certifying entity to 15 disclose the immigration status of a victim or person requesting the certification only under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 16 17 certain certifications of victim helpfulness for U Nonimmigrant Status certification.
