- 2 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
 3 THAT ARE SOLD IN POWDER OR CRYSTALLINE FORM FOR DIRECT USE OR USE IN
 4 COMBINATION WITH WATER OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE.
- 5 (B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 6 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.
- 7 (2) EACH VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2016.
