4 (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT AMERICAN
5 INDIANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL
6 PROCLAIM NOVEMBER AS AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE MONTH.

7 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL
8 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE MONTH PROPERLY
9 WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2014.
