- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring an individual attending a woman for pregnancy to 4 submit to a medical laboratory a blood sample taken from the woman at the 5 time the individual first examines the woman and, under certain circumstances, 6 at the time of delivery; requiring the medical laboratory that receives the blood 7 sample to perform a certain hepatitis B surface antigen test; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the testing of pregnant women 8
