## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Elimination of Concurrent Sentencing for Child Sexual**  
3 **Offenses**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing that a sentence imposed for a violation of a certain  
5 sexual offense in which the victim of the offense is a minor shall be consecutive  
6 to and not concurrent with any other sentence imposed for any crime based on  
7 the act establishing that violation.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Criminal Law**

16 **3–325.**

17 **A SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR A VIOLATION OF §§ 3–303 THROUGH 3–312, §**  
18 **3–314, § 3–315, OR § 3–324 OF THIS SUBTITLE IN WHICH THE VICTIM OF THE**  
19 **OFFENSE IS A MINOR SHALL BE CONSECUTIVE TO AND NOT CONCURRENT WITH**  
20 **ANY OTHER SENTENCE IMPOSED FOR ANY CRIME BASED ON THE ACT**  
21 **ESTABLISHING THAT VIOLATION.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
23 October 1, 2010.
