A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Police and Correctional Training Commissions – Staff – Appointing and**
3 **Supervisory Authority**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the appointing authority for, the supervisory authority
5 over, and the classification of the executive director, the deputy director, and
6 certain other employees of the Correctional Training Commission and the Police
7 Training Commission; providing for the construction of this Act; and generally
8 relating to the staff of the Correctional Training Commission and the Police
9 Training Commission.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Correctional Services**

1 (a) (1) [With the approval of the Secretary, the Commission] **THE**
2 **SECRETARY** shall appoint an Executive Director.

3 (2) The Executive Director shall perform general administrative
4 functions.

5 (3) The Executive Director serves at the pleasure of the [Commission]
6 **SECRETARY**.

7 (b) (1) [With the approval of the Secretary, the Commission] **THE**
8 **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR** shall appoint a Deputy Director and any other employees
9 that the Commission considers necessary to perform general administrative and
10 training management functions **AND TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE**.

11 (2) The Deputy Director and other employees appointed under
12 paragraph (1) of this subsection shall serve at the pleasure of the [Commission]
13 **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**.

14 (c) [With the approval of the Secretary, the Commission shall employ other
15 individuals as necessary to carry out this subtitle.

16 (d) The Executive Director, the Deputy Director, and other employees of the
17 Commission [are entitled to receive compensation as established by the Commission in
18 accordance with the State budget] **SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS SPECIAL APPOINTEES**
19 **WITHIN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**.

20 **Article – Public Safety**

22 (a) (1) [With the approval of the Secretary, the Commission] **THE**
23 **SECRETARY** shall appoint an executive director.

24 (2) The executive director shall perform general administrative and
25 training management functions.

26 (3) The executive director serves at the pleasure of the [Commission]
27 **SECRETARY**.

28 (b) (1) [With the approval of the Secretary, the Commission] **THE**
29 **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR** shall appoint a deputy director and any other employees that
30 the Commission considers necessary to perform general administrative and training
31 management functions **AND TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE**.

1 (2) The deputy director and other employees appointed under
2 paragraph (1) of this subsection shall serve at the pleasure of the [Commission]
3 **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.**

4 (c) [With the approval of the Secretary, the Commission shall employ other
5 individuals as necessary to carry out this subtitle.

6 (d) The executive director, deputy director, and other employees of the
7 Commission [are entitled to receive compensation as established by the Commission in
8 accordance with the State budget] **SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS SPECIAL APPOINTEES**
9 **IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this subtitle shall not be
11 construed to supplement any existing contractual rights or presently existing
12 obligations to skilled service employees of the Police and Correctional Training
13 Commissions.

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2011.
