- 24 (2) THE LIQUOR IS SOLD ONLY BY THE DRINK;
- 25 (3) THE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ARE SOLD ONLY DURING THE
- 26 FUNCTION;
- 27 (4) THE LICENSE HOLDER DOES NOT SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR
- 28 FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION;

TO BE CARE	(5) THE LICENSE HOLDER DOES NOT ALLOW BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR RIED OFF THE PREMISES; AND
AND LIQUO	(6) FOOD IS PROVIDED AT THE FUNCTION WHERE THE BEER, WINE, R ARE PROVIDED.
