## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Public Safety - Handgun Permit Background Check - Armored Car Company Employees

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of State Police to accept certain background checks from certain armored car companies in place of a certain criminal history records check performed by the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services under certain circumstances; and generally relating to handgun permit background checks.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Public Safety
Section 5-305
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2011 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

> Article - Public Safety

5-305.
(a) In this section, "Central Repository" means the Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services.
(b) [The] Except as Provided in subsection (G) OF THIS SECTION, THE Secretary shall apply to the Central Repository for a State and national criminal history records check for each applicant for a permit.
(c) As part of the application for a criminal history records check, the Secretary shall submit to the Central Repository:
(1) two complete sets of the applicant's legible fingerprints taken on forms approved by the Director of the Central Repository and the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation;
(2) the fee authorized under § 10-221(b)(7) of the Criminal Procedure Article for access to Maryland criminal history records; and
(3) the mandatory processing fee required by the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history records check.
(d) In accordance with §§ 10-201 through 10-234 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the Central Repository shall forward to the applicant and the Secretary a printed statement of the applicant's criminal history record information.
(e) Information obtained from the Central Repository under this section:
(1) is confidential and may not be disseminated; and
(2) shall be used only for the licensing purpose authorized by this section.
(f) The subject of a criminal history records check under this section may contest the contents of the printed statement issued by the Central Repository as provided in § 10-223 of the Criminal Procedure Article.
(G) FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF AN ARMORED CAR COMPANY WHO IS AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT, THE SECRETARY MAY ACCEPT A BACKGROUND CHECK PERFORMED BY THE ARMORED CAR COMPANY IN PLACE OF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IF:
(1) THE BACKGROUND CHECK MEETS THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE; AND
(2) THE SECRETARY PERFORMS A CURSORY CHECK TO VERIFY THE FACTS LISTED IN THE BACKGROUND CHECK.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
