18 19 20	(a) In this section, "Central Repository" means the Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services.
21 22	(b) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION THE Secretary shall apply to the Central Repository for a State and national criminal

history records check for each applicant for a permit.

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- 1 As part of the application for a criminal history records check, the 2 Secretary shall submit to the Central Repository: 3 two complete sets of the applicant's legible fingerprints taken on forms approved by the Director of the Central Repository and the Director of the 4 Federal Bureau of Investigation: 5 6 the fee authorized under § 10–221(b)(7) of the Criminal Procedure (2)7 Article for access to Maryland criminal history records; and 8 (3)the mandatory processing fee required by the Federal Bureau of 9 Investigation for a national criminal history records check. 10 In accordance with §§ 10–201 through 10–234 of the Criminal Procedure (d) Article, the Central Repository shall forward to the applicant and the Secretary a 11 printed statement of the applicant's criminal history record information. 12 13 (e) Information obtained from the Central Repository under this section: is confidential and may not be disseminated; and 14 (1) 15 shall be used only for the licensing purpose authorized by this (2)section. 16 17 The subject of a criminal history records check under this section may contest the contents of the printed statement issued by the Central Repository as 18 19 provided in § 10–223 of the Criminal Procedure Article. 20 FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF AN ARMORED CAR COMPANY WHO IS AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT, THE SECRETARY MAY ACCEPT A BACKGROUND 2122CHECK PERFORMED BY THE ARMORED CAR COMPANY IN PLACE OF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IF: 2324**(1)** THE **BACKGROUND CHECK** MEETS THE **MINIMUM** 25REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE; AND 26**(2)** THE SECRETARY PERFORMS A CURSORY CHECK TO VERIFY
