A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes Relating to Animals – Surgery on Dogs – Penalties**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person, other than a licensed veterinarian using
4 anesthesia, from performing certain procedures on a dog; establishing penalties
5 for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to crimes relating to animals.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Criminal Law**

14 **10–624.**

15 **(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A**
16 **PERSON MAY NOT:**

17 **(1) CROP OR CUT OFF THE EAR OF A DOG;**

18 **(2) DOCK OR CUT OFF THE TAIL OF A DOG;**

19 **(3) CUT OFF THE DEWCLAW OF A DOG; OR**

20 **(4) SURGICALLY BIRTH A DOG.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(B) A PROCEDURE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION**
2 **MAY BE PERFORMED BY A LICENSED VETERINARIAN USING ANESTHESIA ON THE**
3 **ANIMAL.**

4 **(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A**
5 **MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO:**

6 **(1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90**
7 **DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH; AND**

8 **(2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IMPRISONMENT**
9 **NOT EXCEEDING 180 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2014.
