Disclosure of Information of Licensed Persons –

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting, except under certain circumstances, a person from disclosing certain information obtained or generated in the course of exercising the Commissioner of Financial Regulation's authority to investigate certain licensed persons; expanding the definition of "licensed persons" to include certain registered persons and licensed or registered credit reporting agencies and credit services businesses; and generally relating to the disclosure of information obtained or generated in the course of exercising the Commissioner of Financial Regulation's authority to examine or investigate licensed persons.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (a) In this section, "licensed person" means:
- 22 (1) A person required to be licensed **OR REGISTERED** under this article,

- 1 whether or not the person maintains a license **OR REGISTRATION**;
- 2 (2) A PERSON REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER
- 3 TITLE 14, SUBTITLES 12 AND 19 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE, WHETHER OR
- 4 NOT THE PERSON MAINTAINS A LICENSE OR REGISTRATION; and
- 5 [(2)] (3) A [collection agency] PERSON required to be licensed under
- 6 [the] TITLE 7 OF THE Business Regulation Article, whether or not the [collection agency]
- 7 **PERSON** maintains a license.
- 8 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this article, a person, including the
- 9 Commissioner and an employee of and the attorney for the Commissioner's office, may not
- 10 disclose any information obtained or generated in the course of exercising the
- 11 Commissioner's authority to examine **OR INVESTIGATE** licensed persons.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 2019.
