- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to require, if applicable, 4 the submission of a valid registration renewal inspection certificate before renewing 5 a motor vehicle registration; requiring a registration renewal inspection to include a 6 certain examination of certain motor vehicle equipment; providing that a 7 registration renewal inspection certificate shall remain valid for a certain period of 8 time; requiring a registration renewal inspection certificate to include certain 9 information; prohibiting an inspection station from charging more than a certain amount for conducting a registration renewal inspection; and generally relating to 10 11 required vehicle inspections for motor vehicle registration renewal.
