### A BILL ENTITLED

# Election Law – Voting by Absentee Ballot – Prepaid Postage for the Return of Ballots

- FOR the purpose of requiring that certain required envelopes used by certain voters voting
  by absentee ballot to return their ballots include prepaid postage; requiring the State
  Board of Elections to reimburse counties for the costs of prepaid postage for certain
  absentee ballot envelopes for certain voters; and generally relating to prepaid
  postage for the return of certain absentee ballots.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- Article Election Law 16 179-310.18 (a) This subsection applies only to an absentee ballot that is sent by mail. (1)19(2)An absentee ballot shall be enclosed in specially printed envelopes, the 20form and content of which shall be prescribed by the State Board. 21(3)(i) A local board may use either two envelopes or three envelopes.

1 (ii) If two envelopes are used, the inner envelope shall be designated 2 the "ballot/return envelope", and, when issued, it shall fit inside the envelope designated 3 the "outgoing envelope".

4 (iii) If three envelopes are used, the innermost envelope shall be 5 designated the "ballot envelope", which shall fit inside the envelope designated the "return 6 envelope", both of which, when issued, shall fit inside the envelope designated the "outgoing 7 envelope".

### 8 (IV) THE BALLOT/RETURN ENVELOPE DESCRIBED UNDER 9 SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH AND THE RETURN ENVELOPE DESCRIBED 10 UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH PROVIDED TO A VOTER VOTING 11 BY ABSENTEE BALLOT SHALL INCLUDE PREPAID POSTAGE.

12 (4) When voted and returned to the local board, an absentee ballot shall be 13 enclosed in a ballot envelope or ballot/return envelope, on which has been printed an oath 14 prescribed by the State Board.

### 15 (B) THE STATE BOARD SHALL REIMBURSE A COUNTY FOR THE COST OF 16 PREPAID POSTAGE FOR BALLOT/RETURN ENVELOPES AND RETURN ENVELOPES 17 ISSUED BY A COUNTY UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(3)(IV) OF THIS SECTION TO A VOTER 18 VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT.

19 [(b)] (C) If an absentee ballot is sent by the Internet or facsimile transmission, 20 the local board shall provide the voter with an envelope template, the oath prescribed by 21 the State Board, and instructions for marking and returning the absentee ballot.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 October 1, 2015.
