1 "Mercury-added product" means any of the following products if containing 2 elemental mercury or a mercury compound that has been added to the product for any 3 reason: 4 (1) Dyes or pigments; AND (2)Electric switches; and 5 6 Fluorescent lamps. (3)7 6-905.3. 8 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A 9 MARKETER MAY NOT SELL OR PROVIDE TO A CONSUMER INDIVIDUALLY OR AS A PRODUCT COMPONENT: 10 **(1)** 11 AN ELECTRIC SWITCH CONTAINING MERCURY; 12 **(2)** AN ELECTRIC RELAY CONTAINING MERCURY; OR 13 **(3)** A GAS VALVE SWITCH CONTAINING MERCURY. 14 THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ELECTRIC SWITCH, AN ELECTRIC (B) 15 RELAY, OR A GAS VALVE SWITCH THAT IS SOLD OR PROVIDED TO REPLACE A SWITCH 16 OR RELAY THAT IS A COMPONENT OF A LARGER PRODUCT IN USE ON OR BEFORE 17 OCTOBER 1, 2017 2018, IF: 18 **(1)** THE LARGER PRODUCT IS USED IN MANUFACTURING; 19 **(2)** THE LARGER PRODUCT \mathbf{IS} **USED** INGENERATING, \mathbf{A} 20 TRANSMISSION, OR DISTRIBUTING FACILITY FOR ELECTRIC ENERGY, GAS, OR 21WATER; 22THE SWITCH OR RELAY IS INTEGRATED WITH, AND NOT **(3)** 23PHYSICALLY SEPARATE FROM, OTHER COMPONENTS OF THE LARGER PRODUCT; OR **(4)** 24THE USE OF THE SWITCH OR RELAY IS REQUIRED UNDER FEDERAL 25LAW OR REGULATION.
