(Senate Bill 723)

AN ACT concerning

Corporations and Associations – Electronic Copies Fee – Repeal

FOR the purpose of repealing a certain per–page fee for electronic copies of certain documents recorded or filed with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation; and generally relating to the collection of fees by the State Department of Assessments and Taxation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Corporations and Associations

1–203.

(a) In addition to any organization and capitalization fee required under § 1–204 of this subtitle, subject to subsection (c) of this section, the Department shall collect the fees specified in subsection (b) of this section.

(b) (6) For a duplicate of a certificate mentioned in paragraph (5) of this subsection which is issued at the same time as the original, the fee is \$1, and for a **NONELECTRONIC** copy of any other paper recorded or filed with the Department, the fee is \$1 per page.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
