A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Sustainable Maryland Program Fund - Establishment

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Sustainable Maryland Program Fund as a special, 4 nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the University of 5 Maryland Environmental Finance Center to administer the Fund; requiring the 6 State Treasurer to hold the Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; 7 specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the Fund may 8 be used; providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from the Fund; 9 requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; exempting the Fund from a certain provision of law requiring interest earnings on State money to 10 11 accrue to the General Fund of the State; requiring the Governor to include in the 12 annual budget bill a certain appropriation to the Fund; defining a certain term; and 13 generally relating to the Sustainable Maryland Program Fund.
