3 FOR the purpose of altering the manner of election for certain members of the Charles  
4 County Board of Education by specifying that certain members be elected from  
5 certain ~~school board~~ county commissioner districts; ~~requiring the Board of Charles~~  
6 ~~County Commissioners to establish a certain number of school board districts in a~~  
7 ~~certain manner~~; providing for the ballot requirements for a certain election;  
8 requiring the State Board of Elections declare the election of certain candidates;  
9 providing for the qualifications of the elected members of the county board; ~~altering~~  
10 ~~the day the term of an elected member begins~~; establishing staggered terms for the  
11 elected members of the county board beginning with a certain election; prohibiting  
12 elected members from serving more than a certain number of consecutive terms;  
13 ~~requiring the County Commissioners to fill a certain vacancy under certain~~  
14 ~~circumstances~~; establishing a residency requirement for an individual appointed to  
15 fill a certain vacancy; ~~requiring the County Commissioners to interview an applicant~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **ELECTED MEMBER SHALL FORFEIT THE OFFICE IF THE MEMBER:**

4           **(I)** **FAILS TO RESIDE IN THE ~~SCHOOL BOARD~~ COUNTY**  
5 **COMMISSIONER DISTRICT FROM WHICH THE MEMBER WAS ELECTED, UNLESS THIS**  
6 **CHANGE IS CAUSED BY A CHANGE IN BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT;**

7           **(II)** **FAILS TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY; OR**

8           **(III)** **FAILS TO BE A REGISTERED VOTER OF THE COUNTY.**

9           **(3)** **AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED BY OR UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE**  
10 **COUNTY BOARD OR THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO SERVE ON**  
11 **THE COUNTY BOARD.**

12           **[(c)] ~~(F)~~ (D)** All [voting] **ELECTED** members of the Charles County Board shall be  
13 elected[:

14           (1) At] **AT** a general election as required by subsection **[(d)] ~~(G)~~ (E)** of this  
15 section[; and

16           (2) From Charles County at large].

17           **[(d)] ~~(G)~~ (E) (1) (I)** [Each voting] **SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS**  
18 **SUBSECTION, EACH ELECTED** member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on the  
19 ~~[third]~~ **FIRST** Monday in December after the [gubernatorial] **GENERAL** election and until  
20 a successor is elected and qualifies.

21           **(II)** If the ~~[third]~~ **FIRST** Monday in December is a legal holiday, the  
22 term begins on the first day after the ~~[third]~~ **FIRST** Monday in December that is not a legal  
23 holiday.

24           **(2)** **THE TERMS OF MEMBERS, BEGINNING WITH MEMBERS ELECTED**  
25 **AT THE GENERAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER 2022, ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY**  
26 **THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD ON JULY 1,**  
27 **2021.**

28           **(3)** **AN ELECTED MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN TWO**  
29 **CONSECUTIVE TERMS.**

30           **[(e)] ~~(H)~~ (F)** (1) ~~[The voting~~ **ELECTED** members of the county board] ~~IN THE~~  
31 ~~EVENT OF A VACANCY OF AN ELECTED MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD, THE~~

1 ~~COUNTY COMMISSIONERS~~ shall select a qualified individual to fill any vacancy on the  
2 board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is elected and qualifies.

3 **(2) AN INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY OF A MEMBER**  
4 ~~ELECTED FROM A SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICT~~ **AN ELECTED MEMBER SHALL BE A**  
5 **RESIDENT OF THE SAME SCHOOL BOARD COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT AS THAT**  
6 **OF THE VACATING MEMBER.**

7 **[(2) (3)]** An interview of an applicant for a vacancy on the board shall be  
8 conducted by the ~~board~~ **COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** at a meeting open to the public.

9 **[(3) (4)]** (i) The ~~board~~ **COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** shall publish a  
10 list of the names of the applicants for a vacancy on the board at least 2 weeks before the  
11 interview of the first applicant is scheduled to occur.

12 (ii) Public notice of the date, time, and location of each interview  
13 shall be published:

14 1. At least 2 weeks before the interview is scheduled to occur;  
15 and

16 2. In the same manner as a public notice of a regular meeting  
17 of the board is published.

18 **[(4) (5)]** The ~~board is~~ **COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ARE** not required to  
19 conduct discussions of the applicants or make the final selection of the **[voting]** member **TO**  
20 **FILL A VACANCY OF THE ELECTED MEMBER** at a meeting open to the public.

21 **[(f) (g)]** (1) With the approval of the Governor, the State Board may remove  
22 **[a voting] AN ELECTED** member of the county board for any of the following reasons:

23 (i) Immorality;

24 (ii) Misconduct in office;

25 (iii) Incompetency; or

26 (iv) Willful neglect of duty.

27 (2) Before removing **[a voting] AN ELECTED** member, the State Board  
28 shall send the **[voting] ELECTED** member a copy of the charges pending and give the  
29 **[voting] ELECTED** member an opportunity within 10 days to request a hearing.

30 (3) If the **[voting] ELECTED** member requests a hearing within the 10-day  
31 period:

1 (i) The State Board shall promptly hold a hearing, but a hearing  
2 may not be set within 10 days after the State Board sends the [voting] ELECTED member  
3 a notice of the hearing; and

4 (ii) The [voting] ELECTED member shall have an opportunity to be  
5 heard publicly before the State Board in the [voting] ELECTED member's own defense, in  
6 person or by counsel.

7 (4) [A voting] AN ELECTED member removed under this subsection has  
8 the right to a de novo review of the removal by the Circuit Court for Charles County.

9 [(g)] ~~(H)~~ (H) (1) The student member of the Charles County Board shall be an  
10 11th or 12th grade student in the Charles County Public School System.

11 (2) The student member, and an alternate, shall be selected [in accordance  
12 with procedures approved by the board. These procedures shall reflect recommendations  
13 by and involvement of] BY the Charles County Association of Student Councils.

14 (3) The term of the student member shall be 1 year.

15 (4) (I) The student member [may not vote, but may indicate a  
16 preference for or against any question before] SHALL BE A VOTING MEMBER OF the board.

17 (II) THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY VOTE ON ALL MATTERS  
18 BEFORE THE BOARD EXCEPT THOSE RELATING TO:

19 1. HEARINGS ON APPEALS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION  
20 PLACEMENTS;

21 2. HEARINGS HELD UNDER §§ 4-205 AND 7-305 OF THIS  
22 ARTICLE;

23 3. PERSONNEL MATTERS, INCLUDING THOSE UNDER §§  
24 6-201 AND 6-202 OF THIS ARTICLE;

25 4. APPOINTMENT, SALARY, AND EVALUATION OF THE  
26 COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT;

27 5. COLLECTIVE BARGAINING DECISIONS;

28 6. CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS; AND

29 7. SCHOOL CLOSINGS, OPENINGS, AND BOUNDARIES.

 2 county board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to  
 3 ~~special education placements, collective bargaining, or hearings held under § 6-202 of this~~

14 ~~¶(a) (B)~~ The county board shall elect ~~¶a chair and¶~~ a vice chair from among its  
 15 ~~REMAINING ELECTED~~ members at an annual meeting to be held on the second Tuesday  
 16 in January.

17 ~~¶(b) (C)~~ If there is a vacancy in the office of chair or vice chair, the county board  
 18 shall elect a replacement within 30 days after the vacancy occurs.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the initial terms of the elected  
 20 members of the Charles County Board of Education shall expire as follows:

21 (1) the members elected from ~~school board~~ the county commissioner  
 22 ~~districts 1, 3, and 5 and the member elected from the county at large~~ at the general election  
 23 in November 2022, shall serve for a term of 4 years until a successor is elected and qualifies;  
 24 and

25 (2) the ~~members~~ member elected from ~~school board districts 2, 4, and 6~~ the  
 26 county at-large at the general election in November 2022, shall serve for a term of 2 years  
 27 until a successor is elected and qualifies.

28 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
 29 1, 2021.
