BY adding to Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 22–1005.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. ____)(6lr1406) (S.B. 724) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2016) SECTION 1.
