- 16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN TALBOT COUNTY.
- 17 (B) A STUDENT WHO RESIDES IN THE GEOGRAPHICAL ATTENDANCE
- 18 AREA OF ONE SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY MAY REPRESENT ANOTHER
- 19 SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY IN AN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC
- 20 ACTIVITY THAT IS NOT OFFERED IN THE RESIDENT SCHOOL.
- 21 (C) THE STUDENT MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE ATHLETIC ACTIVITY
- 22 WITHOUT TRANSFERRING TO THE SECONDARY SCHOOL OUTSIDE OF THE
- 23 STUDENT'S GEOGRAPHICAL ATTENDANCE AREA.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
