- FOR the purpose of designating certain weekends each year to be tax—free weekends during which the sale of certain emergency preparedness equipment is exempt from the sales and use tax; requiring the Comptroller to publish a certain list on or before a certain date; authorizing the Comptroller to amend a certain list under certain circumstances; providing for the termination of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to sales and use tax—free weekends for the sale of emergency preparedness equipment.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EQUIPMENT" MEANS 20 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS ITEMS AS DETERMINED BY THE COMPTROLLER.
- 21 (B) (1) THE FOLLOWING WEEKENDS SHALL BE TAX-FREE WEEKENDS FOR
- 22 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EQUIPMENT SHOPPING DURING WHICH THE
- 23 EXEMPTION UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL APPLY:

- 4 (II) BEGINNING IN CALENDAR YEAR 2020, THE WEEKEND THAT
 5 CONSISTS OF THE FIRST FRIDAY THROUGH THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY IMMEDIATELY
 6 PRECEDING THE OFFICIAL START OF THE ATLANTIC HURRICANE SEASON AS
 7 DETERMINED BY THE NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION.
- 8 (2) DURING THE TAX-FREE WEEKENDS ESTABLISHED UNDER 9 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO 10 THE SALE OF ANY ITEM OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EQUIPMENT WITH A 11 TAXABLE PRICE OF \$60 OR LESS.
- 12 (C) (1) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2019, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL
 13 PUBLISH ON THE COMPTROLLER'S WEBSITE A LIST OF EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
 14 EQUIPMENT ELIGIBLE FOR A SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION UNDER SUBSECTION
 15 (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 16 (2) AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE TAX-FREE WEEKEND IN
 17 CALENDAR YEAR 2019, THE COMPTROLLER MAY AMEND THE LIST OF EMERGENCY
 18 PREPAREDNESS EQUIPMENT THAT IS EXEMPT FROM TAXATION FOR EACH
 19 SUBSEQUENT TAX-FREE WEEKEND.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
