## State Personnel - Individuals With Disabilities - Hiring Preferences

3 FOR the purpose of requiring an appointing authority to apply a certain credit on a 4 selection test for certain positions in the State Personnel Management System for 5 an individual with a certain disability; requiring a certain appointing authorities for 6 certain positions in the Judicial, Legislative, and Executive branches authority for a 7 certain position in the Executive Branch of State government to develop a hiring 8 preference for an individual with a certain disability that is equivalent to a certain 9 credit applied on a certain selection test; repealing a requirement that a certain 10 appointing authority apply a certain credit on a selection test for an eligible veteran 11 with a service connected disability; and generally relating to hiring preferences for 12 individuals with disabilities.
