(A) IN THIS SECTION, "CHRONIC HEALTH CONDITION" MEANS A HEALTH CONDITION OR DISEASE THAT IS PERSISTENT OR LONG-LASTING IN ITS EFFECTS OF COMES WITH TIME AND REQUIRES ONGOING MEDICAL ATTENTION.			
(B) EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE SHALL DESIGNATE A CASE MANAGER FOR STUDENTS WITH CHRONIC HEALTH CONDITIONS.
