- 3 (C) ALL ADVERTISING FOR MEDICAL CANNABIS OR MEDICAL CANNABIS
- 4 PRODUCTS SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT THAT THE PRODUCT IS FOR USE ONLY BY
- 5 A QUALIFYING PATIENT.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 7 October 1, 2019.
