A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Refillable Container Permits**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Frederick County
4 to issue a refillable container permit for draft beer and for wine to a holder of a Class
5 A alcoholic beverages license or a Class B alcoholic beverages license; providing for
6 certain permit fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick
7 County.

26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

27 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 (a) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 11 (“Additional License Privileges”)
6 of Division I of this article apply in the County without exception or variation:

7 (1) § 4–1102 (“Corkage — Consuming wine not purchased from license
8 holder on licensed premises”); and

9 (2) § 4–1103 (“Removal of partially consumed bottle of wine from licensed
10 premises”).

11 (b) The following sections of Title 4, Subtitle 11 (“Additional License Privileges”)
12 of Division I of this article [do not] apply in the County:

13 (1) § 4–1104 (“Refillable container permit — Draft beer”), **SUBJECT TO §**
14 **20–1104 OF THIS SUBTITLE**; and

15 (2) § 4–1104 (“Refillable container permit — Wine”), **SUBJECT TO §**
16 **20–1105 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

18 **(A) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A REFILLABLE CONTAINER PERMIT FOR DRAFT**
19 **BEER TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A OR CLASS B LICENSE.**

26 1, 2016.
