15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19	(H-1) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF
20	THIS SUBSECTION, WHEN THE STATE REIMBURSES THE COSTS OF A
21	FORWARD-FUNDED PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION OR PUBLIC SCHOOL
22	CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, THE STATE SHALL REMIT THE FUNDS TO THE

- 1 (2) THE REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS RECEIVED BY A COUNTY
 2 GOVERNMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED
 3 ONLY FOR REQUIRED PAYMENTS FOR DEBT INCURRED BY THE COUNTY FOR
 4 PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION OR PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
 5 PROJECTS.
- 6 (3) THE STATE MAY NOT REMIT REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS TO THE 7 COUNTY BOARD.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 June 1, 2012.
