1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City Youth Data Hub – Establishment**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Baltimore City Youth Data Hub for the purpose of
4 promoting well-being of youth and improving access to and cost-efficiency of youth
5 programs; establishing an executive committee and providing for a manager to
6 operate the Baltimore City Youth Data Hub; providing that certain activities of the
7 executive committee and manager are not subject to the Open Meetings Act or the
8 Public Information Act; authorizing certain entities to provide data to the Baltimore
9 City Youth Data Hub; providing for the authorized uses and ownership of the data
10 provided to the Baltimore City Youth Data Hub; establishing certain penalties and
11 immunity under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the Baltimore City
12 Youth Data Hub.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
6 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 (B) “AGGREGATE” MEANS TO CORRELATE, LINK, OR ASSOCIATE
13 PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION FROM ONE PROVIDER WITH
14 PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION FROM ANY OTHER PROVIDER INSIDE
15 THE BALTIMORE CITY YOUTH DATA HUB.

16 (C) “AUTHORIZED PURPOSE” MEANS AN EVIDENCE–BASED, TESTABLE
17 INQUIRY THAT IS INTENDED TO YIELD RESULTS THAT FURTHER THE PURPOSE OF
18 THE BALTIMORE CITY YOUTH DATA HUB.

19 (D) “BALTIMORE CITY YOUTH DATA HUB” MEANS AN INTEGRATED,
20 ELECTRONIC DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM THAT LINKS DATA ABOUT YOUTH FROM
21 ANY PROVIDER.

22 (E) (1) “DATA” MEANS ANY INFORMATION ABOUT A YOUTH.

23 (2) “DATA” INCLUDES NAMES, ADDRESSES, TELEPHONE NUMBERS,
24 DATES OF BIRTH, INFORMATION ON GENDER, ETHNICITY, AND ENGLISH LANGUAGE
25 PROFICIENCY, FAMILY OR PERSONAL INCOMES, OTHER FAMILY DATA, SOCIAL
26 SECURITY NUMBERS, STUDENT OR EMPLOYEE IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS,
27 ENROLLMENT AND ATTENDANCE DATES, PERFORMANCE INFORMATION IN ANY
28 JOBS, INTERNSHIPS, SCHOOLS, OR OTHER PROGRAMS, CURRENT AND PAST HEALTH
29 INFORMATION, INCLUDING BIRTH WEIGHTS, MATERNAL HEALTH AT BIRTH, AND
30 EXPOSURE TO LEAD, AND INFORMATION ON THE RECEIPT INDIVIDUALLY OR BY
31 FAMILY OF WELFARE BENEFITS.

5 (G) “DE-IDENTIFIED DATA” MEANS ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE
6 INFORMATION THAT IS PERMANENTLY REMOVED IN A MANNER THAT LEAVES NO
7 REASONABLE BASIS TO BELIEVE THAT THE REMAINING INFORMATION CAN BE USED
8 TO SUCCESSFULLY LINK THE DE-IDENTIFIED DATA TO A PARTICULAR INDIVIDUAL.

9 (H) “EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE” MEANS THE BODY THAT PROVIDES VISION,
10 OVERSIGHT, AND LEADERSHIP FOR THE BALTIMORE CITY YOUTH DATA HUB.

11 (I) “MANAGER” MEANS THE NONGOVERNMENTAL CUSTODIAN OF THE
12 BALTIMORE CITY YOUTH DATA HUB RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS OPERATION, UPKEEP,
13 AND SECURITY.

14 (J) “PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION” ~~MEANS~~ INCLUDES:

16 (2) THE NAME OF AN INDIVIDUAL’S PARENT OR OTHER FAMILY

8 THAT ADDRESS, AT A MINIMUM, DATA SECURITY AND ACCESS, SECURITY INCIDENT
9 AND DISASTER RECOVERY PROCEDURES, AND RECORDING AND MONITORING OF

2 **DATA RECIPIENTS REGARDING DATA RECEIVED FROM THE BALTIMORE CITY YOUTH**
