A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Drivers’ Licenses and Vehicle Registrations – Mailing Address**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to include a vehicle owner’s
4 mailing address on the vehicle registration card; requiring an applicant for a driver’s
5 license to provide the Administration with a mailing address; requiring drivers’
6 licenses issued by the Administration to display a mailing address; requiring
7 individuals who have applied for or obtained a driver’s license to notify the
8 Administration of a change in mailing address; making a stylistic change; and
9 generally relating to drivers’ licenses and vehicle registrations.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

1 When it registers a vehicle, the Administration shall issue and deliver to the owner
2 a registration card that contains:

3 (1) The date issued;

4 (2) The name [and], Maryland **RESIDENCE** address, **AND MAILING**
5 **ADDRESS** of the owner;

6 (3) The registration number assigned by the Administration to the vehicle;
7 and

8 (4) Such description of the vehicle as the Administrator determines.

10 (a) Each application for a driver’s license shall be made on the form that the
11 Administration requires.

12 (b) The application shall state:

13 (1) The full name, Maryland residence address, **MAILING ADDRESS**, race,
14 sex, height, weight, general physical condition, and date of birth of the applicant;

16 (d) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, each noncommercial Class
17 A, B, C, or M license issued by the Administration shall be of the size, design, and content
18 that the Administration specifies.

19 (2) A noncommercial Class A, B, C, or M license shall include:

20 (i) The name [and], **MARYLAND** residence address, **AND MAILING**
21 **ADDRESS** of the licensee;

22 (ii) The date of birth of the licensee;

23 (iii) A description of the licensee, which shall include the height,
24 weight, and sex of the licensee;

25 (iv) A color photograph of the applicant that is taken in accordance
26 with a procedure that the Administration requires;

27 (v) The type or class of vehicles that the license authorizes the
28 licensee to drive;

29 (vi) The signature and seal of the issuing agent; and

1 (vii) A space for the signature of the licensee.

3 (a) If any individual who has applied for or obtained a driver’s license under this
4 subtitle moves from the **RESIDENCE ADDRESS, OR IS NO LONGER ABLE TO RECEIVE**
5 **MAIL AT THE MAILING** address, given in the application or shown on the license, the
6 individual shall, within 30 days of the change, notify the Administration in writing of the
7 former address and new address and the identifying number of any license issued to the
8 individual.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2017.
