3 FOR the purpose of requiring an individual to provide certain information to a court in a 4 certain action for a change of name; requiring certain documents to be served on $\mathbf{5}$ certain persons if the individual whose name is sought to be changed is a minor; 6 prohibiting a court from requiring publication of certain notice in an action for 7 change of name; authorizing an individual to object to a petition for change of name; 8 providing for a hearing on an objection to a petition under certain circumstances; 9 requiring a court to grant a request to shield certain court records under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to 1011 changing rules concerning an action for a change of name.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any petition for a change of name filed before the effective date of this Act.
