- 15 (XVII) SHALL PROVIDE, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF 16 THE STATE BUDGET, ACUPUNCTURE SERVICES ADMINISTERED BY A HEALTH CARE 17 PRACTITIONER WHO IS:
- 18 1. LICENSED UNDER TITLE 1A OF THE HEALTH 19 OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE; AND
- 20 **COMPARTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE OF THE** 21 **PRACTITIONER**.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
