- 1 (B) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL ALLOW A STUDENT WHO IS NOT 2 ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL TO PARTICIPATE IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY 3 SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL TO THE SAME EXTENT THAT A STUDENT WHO IS 4 ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY 5 IF THE STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED:
- 6 (1) PARTICIPATES IN A HOME INSTRUCTION PROGRAM UNDER 7 WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT;
