## Video Lottery Operation License - Renewal

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of years before the end of the term of a video lottery operation license that a licensee may apply for renewal of the license; providing for 4 5 the term of a renewed license; requiring the State Lottery and Gaming Control 6 Commission to renew a certain license unless the Commission makes a certain finding; requiring the Commission, under certain circumstances, to provide a 7 8 licensee a certain hearing; providing that certain provisions of law relating to the 9 renewal of certain licenses do not apply to video lottery operation licenses; and generally relating to the renewal of video lottery operation licenses. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 20 (a) The initial term of a video lottery operation license is 15 years from the date 21 on which the video lottery facility is issued the license by the Commission.
  - (b) During the initial term of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall provide the Commission with an annual update of the information required under this subtitle for the issuance of a license by the date set by the Commission in regulations and on the form required by the Commission.



- 1 (c) Two years before the expiration of the INITIAL 15-YEAR LICENSE term OR
  2 A RENEWAL TERM of a video lottery operation license, the licensee shall file with the
  3 Commission a notice of intent to [reapply for] APPLY FOR RENEWAL OF the license under
  4 this subtitle.
- 5 (d) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO THE FIRST RENEWAL OF A VIDEO 6 LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE FOLLOWING THE INITIAL 15-YEAR TERM AND EACH 7 SUBSEQUENT RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE.
- 8 (2) A RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE IS FOR A 9 TERM OF 10 YEARS.
- 10 **(3)** [Within 1 year of] **AT LEAST 2 YEARS BEFORE** the end of the initial 15—year license term **OR A RENEWAL TERM**, a video lottery operation licensee may 12 [reapply for a] **FILE AN APPLICATION TO RENEW A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION** license that has a license term of 10 years and a license fee to be established by statute.
- 14 (4) ON PROPER APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A VIDEO LOTTERY
  15 OPERATION LICENSE, THE COMMISSION SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE UNLESS THE
  16 COMMISSION FINDS THAT THE LICENSEE IS NO LONGER QUALIFIED UNDER THIS
  17 SUBTITLE TO HOLD A LICENSE.
- 18 (5) BEFORE DENYING AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, 19 THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE THE VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSEE AN 20 OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING.
- 21 (e) If a licensee has its license revoked or otherwise surrenders the license, the 22 video lottery operation license reverts to the State.

- 24 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION 25 LICENSE.
- 26 **(B)** Subject to the power of the Commission to deny, revoke, or suspend a license, a license in force may be renewed by the Commission for the next succeeding license period on:
- 29 (1) proper application for renewal; and
- 30 (2) payment of all required application, license, and other fees and taxes.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
