1 AN ACT concerning

## Insurance - Fraud Violations - Civil and Criminal Actions

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that a criminal prosecution for engaging in insurance 4 fraud may be brought in certain counties in the State; authorizing the Maryland 5 Insurance Commissioner, for a civil fraud violation, to impose administrative 6 penalties and order restitution under a certain provision of law under certain 7 circumstances; providing that, if insurance fraud is determined to have occurred 8 in a certain location, a criminal or civil fraud action for all related violations 9 may be joined in the same action; and generally relating to civil and criminal 10 actions for insurance fraud.
