22 23 24 25 26 27	This amendment directs a vendor to provide a delivery ticket by e-mail if a purchaser of a bulk delivery of liquid fuel sold for heating residential, industrial or commercial space or water or motor vehicle fuel submits a written request to receive a delivery ticket by e-mail instead of a paper delivery ticket. The amendment provides that delivery tickets provided by e-mail must be provided to the purchaser by e-mail within 24 hours after delivery.
