Task force established. Resolved: That the Task Force to Review Work Practices and Treatment of Pharmacists, referred to in this resolve as "the task force," is 16 17 established. 18 Sec. 2. Task force membership. Resolved: That the task force consists of 9 19 members appointed as follows: 20 1. Two members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, including 21 members from each of the 2 parties holding the largest number of seats in the Legislature; 22 2. Three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the 23 House, including members from each of the 2 parties holding the largest number of seats 24 in the Legislature; and 25 3. Four members appointed by the Governor who possess expertise in the subject matter of the review, at least one of whom must be a member of the Board of Pharmacy at 26 27 the time of appointment. The Governor shall consider any recommendations submitted 28 within 20 days of the effective date of this resolve by the statewide associations 29 representing pharmacists and pharmacies regarding persons who have such expertise. 30 Sec. 3. Chairs. Resolved: That the first-named Senate member is the Senate chair 31 and the first-named House of Representatives member is the House chair of the task force. 32 Sec. 4. Appointments; convening of task force. Resolved: That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this 33

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resolve. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative

1	Council once all appointments have been completed. After appointment of all members,
2	the chairs shall call and convene the first meeting of the task force. If 30 days or more after
3	the effective date of this resolve a majority of but not all appointments have been made, the

- Sec. 7. Report. Resolved: That, no later than December 6, 2023, the task force shall submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Health Coverage, Insurance and Financial Services based on the review that includes its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, for presentation to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.'
