Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,144,815 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$6,516,631 in fiscal year 2022-23 for the net costs of providing MaineCare coverage for additional preventive oral health services for MaineCare-eligible adults 21 years of age and older beginning April 1, 2022 and to develop a public education campaign. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be included for the FMAP match.
