I	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17001, sub-§13, ¶A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 800, is further amended to read:
4	A. "Earnable compensation" includes:
5	(1) Workers' compensation benefits;
6	(2) Maintenance, if any;
7 8 9 10	(3) Any money paid by an employer to a 3rd party under a tax sheltered annuity contract or a deferred compensation plan for the future benefit of an employee provided that as long as the money is not derived from amounts excluded from earnable compensation by paragraph B; and
11	(4) Pick-up contributions-; and
12 13	(5) Stipends received as part of the member's compensation for services rendered in an employment position.
14	SUMMARY
15 16 17	This bill requires that stipends paid to a member of the Maine Public Employees Retirement System be counted as earnable compensation for purposes of calculating retirement benefits.
