9	This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment clarifies
0	that the period of service for a person who might be eligible for disability retirement benefits under the bill's provision ends as of the date of any settlement agreement
2	pursuant to a claim brought under the State's Whistleblowers' Protection Act.
