Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to allow reimbursement for ultrasound and fetal nonstress test procedures through telehealth under MaineCare program. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules regarding reimbursement under the MaineCare program to allow reimbursement for ultrasound procedures and fetal nonstress tests performed remotely in a residence or other off-site location through telehealth under the MaineCare program. For purposes of this resolve, "telehealth" has the same meaning as in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3173-H, subsection 1, paragraph D.
