3	amended to read:
4	A. In accordance with section 10105, subsection 1, the commissioner may at any time
5	authorize a A landowner, a person on behalf of the landowner, a person who maintains
6	a trail as part of a club or organization that maintains trails or an agent of the department
7	to may take or kill nuisance beaver.

9	This bill allows a landowner, a person on behalf of a landowner or a person who
10	maintains a trail as part of a club or organization that maintains trails to take or kill nuisance
11	beaver.
