This bill removes the requirement that the Department of Health and Human 17 Services, Background Check Center be used to screen prospective employees of child 18 19 care facilities and family child care providers. Instead, this bill allows the criminal background check used for new and continuing school employees to fulfill the state and 20 federal requirements for a mandatory criminal background check for a person who 21 22 provides child care in a child care facility, a family child care provider and a person who provides day care in that person's home for one or 2 children whose care is paid for by 23 24 state or federal funds.
