Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §765 is enacted to read:
§765. Absentee ballot secured drop boxes
The Secretary of State may provide to each municipality secured drop boxes that are accessible by only the municipal clerk for depositing a voted absentee ballot in accordance with section 754-A, subsection 1, paragraph D.
SUMMARY
Current law authorizes voters or immediate family members of voters to return a voted absentee ballot by depositing the ballot into a secured drop box accessible by only the municipal clerk. This bill authorizes the Secretary of State to provide to each municipality secured drop boxes that are accessible by only the municipal clerk for depositing a voted absentee ballot.
